REACH Declaration

22 March 2010

On 29 May 2007 the EU passed new legislation that covers the registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemicals within the European Union. This new regulation is commonly known as REACH (Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals). The essence of REACH is the registration of chemical substances that are either manufactured or imported in quantities of greater than one metric ton (1MT) per year.

AMI supports the underlying ideas and goals of REACH, which are consistent with our own commitments to promote environmentally responsible designs and manufacturing. After careful review of the legislation and specifically the definition of an article as defined in EC Regulation 1907/2006, Title II, Chapter 1, Article 7.1(a) & (b), it is AMI's view that the products AMI sells to you are considered articles. That being said, the definition in § 7.1(b) requires registration of an article only if it contains a regulated substance that "is intended to be released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use". AMI's analysis is that our products are not articles to be registered when used as they are intended and anticipated.

Also of note, AMI's products do not contain any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as defined in Article 33 (1) & (2) "Substances of Very High Concern" EC Title VII, Chapter 1 Article 57.
